- Seattle Parks Foundation builds out and personalizes web presence and fundraisig support when a partner is onboarded. This means your individualized giving page is crafted with your project in mind. Currently in place and ready to accept gifts, acknowledge donors, and designate to your account with less possibility of error.
- Your partner page acts as a donation landing page, utilizing our already accessible and functioning sites will save time for staff and partners, instead of setting up a second page through the 501 Commons/Washington Gives site with a fee.
- Because we already have a matured reconciliation process, we get your donations in the correct account much faster than if we used an outside platform. This automatic import process into our donor database allows for fast accuracy for many partners who are in critical stages of their work and rely on incoming funding.
